- Eating area
This area is strictly for eating only. The teacher can pull up his/her chair from their desk and move the chair to the eating area tables, to eat with the children. The low-to-the-ground tables (35') and chairs provides toddlers easy in-and-out access to the table.
- Entry area
The entry is area is the first place that parents see, so making the area look presentable is important. There will be a Corner Coat locker that is 35" tall, 24" wide, and 17.5" deep. The locker holds enough space for all students to students to hang their coats, winter gear on the top, and shoes and other accessories can go on the bottom. An area for extra clothes is also available in the Corner Coat Locker. Plenty of storage for all!
- Carpet time/Toy area
Carpet time is for children to sing songs and teachers read books out loud. When those activities are not being done, the children can play with the toys and

A rug 4'x6' provides comfort and learning essentials. Each child can sit on an animal on the rug and that can be their spot
- Art area
Metal Wall Storage Rack to hold the art materials 33' high, 20' wide, 9' deep. The art area is for children to explore their artistic side. The easel is double-sided so two children can be on the easel at once.
- Dramatic play area
I decided to put gross motor in the dramatic play area, so that children can use their imagination while using gross motor skills as well. Play area is 47.5" high, 47.5" wide, and 37" deep. This area will be for children who want to dress up and pretend or play in the play house. This gives the opportunity that if children want to pretend to be in a castle, they can use the playhouse as one. The cubby is for storing accessories and costumes. Cubby is 5" height, 8" wide, and 12" deep.
- Sensory area
Step 2 Cascading Cove Sand and Water Table 23" height, 42.5" wide, and 24" deep. The sand and water table allows children to explore how different objects feel. The table has

an umbrella attached to it as well, so children feel like they are playing at the beach. For example the sand feels squishy, and the water feels wet. Kept in the corner and taken out when ready to explore.

- Quiet/reading area

Nantucket 32" Bookcase to hold all the books. 32" height, 24" wide, and 11.5" deep
Teepee for quiet time with pillows inside so children can relax while they are reading 63" height, 47" wide, and 47" deep. The lamp provides extra light in the area to let children know they are welcomed. A CD player is important so that during naptime or quiet time children can have some tunes in the background to soothe and calm themselves.

- Changing area

The changing area will be by the sink and the bathroom. If possible, the changing station will be in the bathroom with the cabinet hanging up holding the diapers and wiping materials. A step stool will be provided for students who can walk, and be independent walking up to the changing table.

- Nap equipment

Nap equipment needs to be safe and comfortable for children to sleep on. A cot is comfortable and provides enough space for the children to move around on. Toddlers will need to bring in their own blankets and pillows.

- Teachers desk area

An area for the teacher's desk allows the teacher to have their "own space" for paperwork, and extra materials needed for the class.

- Fillers

Posters, and areas for children to hang their work on the wall, allows the children to show off the work they have done to classmates and parents. The posters on the wall help to continue learning, as the children read the posters they learn to understand what they mean and comprehend them.
